SDG 4 Targets

AzTU actively works towards several targets set by SDG 4:

- Ensure equal access to affordable and quality technical, vocational, and higher education:
 AzTU's diverse student body of 9,118 students (including 2,290 new admissions) reflects its
 commitment to providing equal access to higher education, especially in engineering and
 technology, to students from all backgrounds.
- Increase the number of youth and adults with relevant skills for employment, decent jobs, and entrepreneurship: AzTU supports this target through its rigorous academic programs in engineering and technology, aligning curricula with industry needs to equip students with relevant skills.
- Increase the number of scholarships and funding opportunities for higher education students from disadvantaged backgrounds: AzTU's volunteer and outreach programs provide additional opportunities for students from marginalized communities, including first-generation students (756 first-generation students starting their degree at AzTU).
- Enhance the quality of teaching and learning through more inclusive curricula and faculty
 development: AzTU is committed to improving the quality of education through its open
 access to lecture materials and resources, supporting faculty development by sharing the
 latest research and academic resources available globally.
- Promote the development of skills for sustainable development: AzTU's educational programs integrate sustainability and STEM education, fostering skills in innovation, critical thinking, and responsible decision-making.
- Ensure that all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development: Through its outreach activities, including seminars and events such as the "Bibliotherapy" seminar and STEM workshops, AzTU ensures that learners not only gain technical knowledge but also life skills like critical thinking, problem-solving, and a sense of social responsibility.
- Support the creation of inclusive learning environments that are accessible to all: AzTU
 actively promotes equality, diversity, and inclusion with policies that ensure nondiscriminatory academic and social environments, enabling equal participation for students
 of all backgrounds.



SDG 4's Positive Impact on Other SDGs

The initiatives taken by Azerbaijan Technical University (AzTU) in the realm of Quality Education (SDG 4) have far-reaching positive impacts on various Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Here's a detailed analysis of these interconnections:

- Empowering Communities through Access to Education: AzTU's commitment to providing free access to educational materials and resources fosters an inclusive educational environment. By offering lecture materials and full-text books online, the university not only supports its students but also extends its resources to the broader community. This accessibility promotes lifelong learning (SDG 4.3) and empowers individuals in remote or underserved areas to pursue knowledge and education, thus enhancing community empowerment and resilience (SDG 11).
- Fostering Innovation and Economic Growth: The partnerships and projects initiated by AzTU, such as the collaboration with TUSAŞ (Turkish Aviation and Space Industry Company) for "AzTU Turkish Aerospace, MGP 2023," create an ecosystem that stimulates innovation and practical learning. This aligns with SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth) by equipping students not only with theoretical knowledge but also with hands-on experience that will aid in their employability and entrepreneurship, ultimately contributing to economic development.
- Strengthening Social Cohesion and Volunteering: The establishment of the Social Development Center and the active volunteering programs significantly bolster social inclusion and community engagement. Students participating in these initiatives contribute to local schools and communities, fostering an environment of mutual support and collaboration. This work promotes reduced inequalities (SDG 10) and helps build peaceful and inclusive societies (SDG 16).
- Promoting Gender Equality and Inclusivity: AzTU's policies on "Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion" ensure a supportive academic environment free from discrimination. This commitment plays a crucial role in promoting gender equality (SDG 5) and addressing disparities that first-generation students and marginalized groups might face in accessing higher education. By focusing on sustaining an inclusive academic culture, AzTU encourages participation from diverse backgrounds, thereby enhancing educational equity.
- Improving Health and Well-Being: The awareness seminars, like the one on "Bibliotherapy
 psychology of readers," reflect AzTU's holistic approach to education, acknowledging mental
 health and well-being (SDG 3). By promoting reading as a tool for mental wellness, the



university nurtures a culture that values emotional health alongside academic achievement, thereby improving overall community well-being.

Building Partnerships for Education: AzTU's active engagement with other universities,
local schools, and international programs exemplifies the importance of partnerships in
education (SDG 17). Collaborative projects and knowledge sharing enhance the quality of
education and research, providing a platform for continued learning and development across
institutions and communities.

Current situation

Azerbaijan Technical University (AzTU) doesn't offer education programs which entitle graduates to teach at primary school level. Azerbaijan Technical University (AzTU) provides free access to lecture materials and presentations related to courses taught on its own website. AzTU offers open access to full-text books, educational materials on the online academic databases of the AzTU Library Information Center.

The digital repository of the AzTU Library Information Center was established within the EU granted project Developing Research Capacity through Institutional Repositories Network in Azerbaijan (**DIRNA**). The platform aims to support the teaching and research mission of the university, form the digital heritage of university, preserve the collected data for a long-term, and make the information permanently accessible via the Internet by indexing the website in international registries and





directories.

Future Goals

- **1. Increase Graduate Numbers:** Aim to increase the total number of graduates from 2,310 to 3,500 by the year 2028. This will involve enhancing support for students throughout their academic journey and providing additional resources such as tutoring and mentorship programs.
- **2. Enhance Access to Educational Resources:** Expand the range of free access to lecture materials and educational resources on the AzTU website. This includes increasing the number of available courses and materials to promote lifelong learning.
- **3. Promote Digital Literacy:** Implement workshops and training sessions focusing on digital literacy for both students and staff, ensuring that they can effectively utilize the online academic databases and digital repository by the end of 2024.
- **4. Foster Research and Innovation:** Continue to develop the digital repository of the AzTU Library Information Center, ensuring it includes a broader range of academic works and research projects from both students and faculty by 2025.
- **5. Community Engagement and Outreach:** Expand the activities of the Social Development Center, aiming for increased collaboration with local schools and community organizations to facilitate STEM education workshops, seminars, and open days, targeting to reach at least 5,000 community members by 2025.
- **6. Support First-Generation Students:** Implement targeted support programs for first-generation students, aiming to increase retention and graduation rates by 20% over the next three years, particularly focusing on mentorship and academic support initiatives.
- **7. Promote Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion:** Strengthen policies related to equality, diversity, and inclusion, ensuring that all students and staff feel welcomed and supported at AzTU. This includes regular training for faculty and staff on inclusivity practices.
- **8. Enhance Collaborations with Industry:** Increase partnerships with leading companies and organizations, such as TUSAŞ, to provide students with hands-on training and internship opportunities, aiming to involve at least 50% of the student body in practical experiences by 2025.
- **9. Monitor and Evaluate Progress:** Establish a system for regular monitoring and evaluation of educational programs and initiatives at AzTU, ensuring that the university remains responsive to the needs of its students and the community, with annual reports published to track progress against these goals.
